

Fish for 10

The aim of the game is to make pairs of cards whose total is 10. e.g. a 2 and an 8 card could be put down as a pair.

You need: Card pack from 1 (Ace) to 9
2-4 players

To Play: The dealer deals 5 cards to each player
The players take turns to ask for a card from another player (one that they need to make 10)
If the player asked has the card they pass it over and the player has another turn.
If the player asked does not have the card asked for they say FISH
A card is picked up from the pile and the next player has their turn.

Play continues until there are no cards left

The winner is the player with the most pairs when all the cards have been used.

This game can be played with ten frames
